V.	<p>Superintendent Report – Geoff Andrews</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 171K new scholarship money potentially available for new students. Forms can be found on diocesan web site • Free school lunches for the 2021-2022 school year • Met with principals and pastors of diocese. Hope is to allow principals time in classroom to focus on and support active learning. • This is year 5 of accreditation and will happen in March 22-25 and zoom visits will be set for each building.
VI.	<p>Financial Report – John Krajicek</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New members introduced: Angela Bogart, Susan Williams, Gregg Weiss • Statement passed out. See attached. • Ended the year in negative-\$63,577 • Motion to approve Bogart/Perrin and all approved yay
VII.	<p>Principal’s Report / Building Report – Mr. Krajicek</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussions about the Start of School 2021-2022 reopening plan. Lots of discussion about masks or not. • Motion by Gack to approve the Back to School Guidelines as presented by Mr. Krajicek, Principal. Motion failed because the motion was not seconded. • Motion made by Perrin to amend the Return to School Guidelines to include a mask mandate for all staff, students, and others while in the building, saying it is easier to start with a mask and then possibly remove the mandate at a later time. This motion was seconded by Williams. Voting in favor was Perrin, Del Real, Weis. Voting nay was Gack with Bogart abstaining, thus the motion recommendation passed 3-1. • The August Calendar for start of school reviewed. Aug 18 is the first day of school. • John K reviewed the School Improvement Goals with accreditation March 2022.
