Meetings conducted via Zoom. • Policy/Accreditation, looking to become first Diocese in the state to be accredited as a group as opposed to individual schools. • Each school is putting together a presentation that will be shown to visitation team, and will also show to Council at March 21 meeting. John Hamilton is working on presentation. • Goals, 1.) Promoting Viable Catholic Schools. 2.) Integration of Technology 3.) Individual Plans of Study and College/Career Readiness. For example STREAM learning that we are trying to do, having \$50,000 worth of Chrome books through an emergency connectivity fund, we did not have to pay for is a step forward in the right direction. • Working on individual plans of study for students, SHHS is ahead of the curve on a lot of the private and public schools.
